

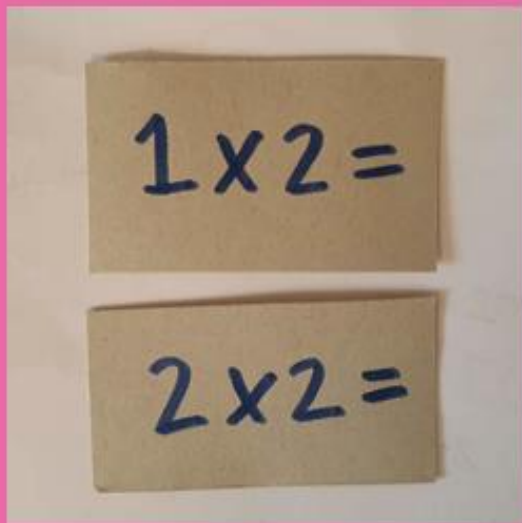
Teaching and Learning Resources

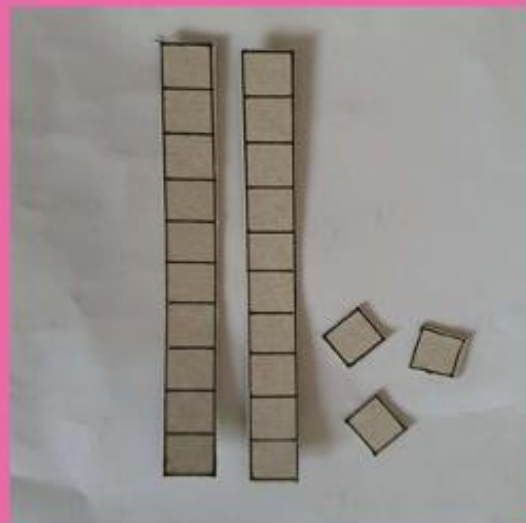


Below we share some ideas of the types of resources that are effective and can be made affordably:

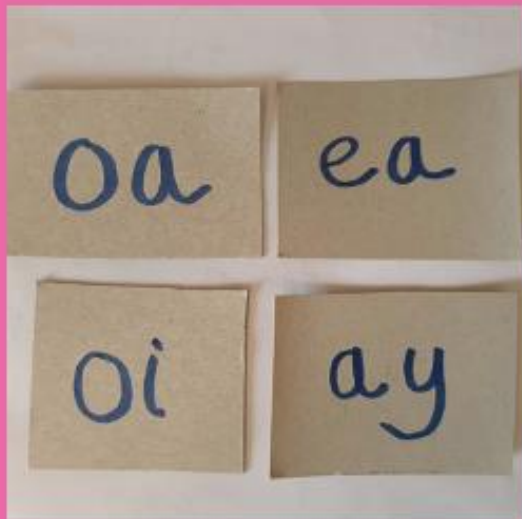
- **Base 10** – Are an excellent resource to teach learners place value. They help learners to visualise what numbers really mean and make learning practical.
- **Phonics sound cards** – Phonics is very important for teaching children to read. Having sound cards enables quick learning of new sounds.
- **Flash cards** – Can be used to help learn and revise many topics. Here they are used for timetables practice.
- **Number cards** – Can be used for ordering and grouping numbers and for sharing answers to increase engagement during teaching time.
