

INCREASED OPPORTUNITIES FOR GIRLS & WOMEN IN SCHOOLS THROUGH EDUCATION FINANCE

KEY INSIGHT

Affordable private school owners accessing loans achieve higher rates of girls' enrolment and employ more female teachers.



Opportunity EduFinance assessed 2019 profile data from a sample of 204 Uganda schools in the EduQuality program. Analysis showed that at schools with a loan, as compared to schools without a loan:



53% of students are girls, compared to 50%



56% of teachers are women, compared to 52%
