## **Case Study:** Ambition for the Needy School, Tamale, Ghana

Ambition for the Needy School is located in the Zagyuri suburb of Tamale, Sagnarigu Municipality, in the Northern Region of Ghana. Established in September 2003, by Ms. Theresa Owusu, a determined farmer and vegetable trader, the school was born out of Theresa's aspiration to provide education despite facing personal challenges that interrupted her own educational journey.

Theresa's vision for Ambition for the Needy School was to ensure that children in areas with limited formal schooling would have access to preprimary

and primary education.

Despite her own educational setbacks, Theresa remained resolute in her commitment to positively impacting children's lives through education.



The school currently caters to **181 learners aged between 3 and 15 years, with 92 boys, and 89 girls,** including two children from the Fulbe community, and two learners with disabilities. Initially a one-teacher school, Ambition for the Needy School now boasts a team of eight teachers, most of whom have been with the school for over 5 years. The school operates on a low-fee model, charging GHS 60 (\$5) per term or GHS 180 (\$15) per year.

Despite the school's efforts to provide affordable education, several challenges hinder its progress. The infrastructure is inadequate, with five simple wooden classrooms accommodating two grades each. Additionally, the school lacks toilet facilities, portable drinking water, and office space for administrative purposes. These limitations affect the teaching and learning environment, making it difficult to provide quality education.
